



ROY'S & SUPERSTARS FOOTY CLUB FAQ SHEET



What is Roy's & Superstars Footy?

Roy's Footy and Superstars Footy are fundamentally the same programs however are aligned to our AFL Club Zones. Roy's Footy is played within the Brisbane Lions Catchment Zone, where Superstars Footy is played with the Gold Coast SUNS Catchment.

They are Development Programs (not competition based) for kids aged 5-8 focusing on skill development and fun.

These programs are an extension of NAB AFL Auskick, where participants play game-based activities leading into modified (non-contact) AFL matches. A maximum of one mid-week training is allowed, plus a one-hour session on Friday - Sunday.

Please note the maximum season length of your club program must be 12 weeks.

Participant Age Groups

All participants must be born within the age groups of 1/1/2012 - 31/12/2014 for the 2019 season. As these are programs, not competitions we do not accept playing up or down consent forms.

How do participants register?

Participants can be directed to our Junior Match Website: www.aflq.com.au/roysandsuperstars

From here participants should select the program (Roy's or Superstars) and follow the prompts to confirm your email address and chose your club to continue.

Participants must register for these programs and cannot be transferred from Auskick. Moving forward if the participant choses to transition to U8s, then clubs will have the transfer function to be able to move data from Roy's/Superstars to U8s.

- Club fee (\$0, \$25, \$50)

Not participated in Auskick in this Calendar year?

- State Registration Fee (\$80)
- Club fee (\$0, \$25, \$50)

What is included in the \$80 State Registration Fee?

The state registration fee includes -

- Insurance
- Registration under AFL Queensland
- Administration costs

If the child HAS NOT participated in Auskick in this calendar year, do they need to?

No, they do not have to participate in Auskick in the calendar year, however they must pay the State Registration Fee of \$80 plus your clubs fee to participate.

Note that the participant will NOT receive a benefits pack, so we urge participants to play Auskick first, then Roys or Superstars Footy.

If the child HAS participated in Auskick in this calendar year, do they have to play again this year?

No, however if they would like to participate again they're more than welcomed too.

Can a participant use the 'Get Started Voucher'?

These can be accepted; however, they are not built into the registration form. If a family wishes to use one, please take a manual registration & physically take the voucher from the family to claim it later as per the usual claim process.

Clubs are then required to update the database to reflect this participant as 'paid'.

Should a participant use the Get Started Voucher for the \$80 State Registration Fee, Clubs are required to contact their Development Coordinator to arrange an invoice as these monies belong to AFL Queensland.

Does AFL Queensland Run Coaching Courses for this program?

All Coaches are required to complete an online Level 1 Junior Coaching Course. From here, local Development Coordinators and Regional Managers will work with clubs to offer at least one FREE practical session upskill parents who have volunteered their time to coach this season.

Typically, these courses will take place within the months of March - June prior. Coaches who attend these courses will also receive a branded Lanyard as well as a hardcopy of our Coaching Handbook.
