

The 2022 Gold Coast Suns Indigenous Guernsey was collaboratively designed by Yugambeh artist Luther Cora from the Gold Coast region, and Larrakia Artist from Darwin in the Northern Territory, Trent Lee.

The Sun is the centre piece and foundation of the football club's journey. It represents the meeting place for everyone which embraces people from all cultures and background.

The Eagle represents the Gold Coast and is a totem to some of the Traditional custodians from the Yugambeh language group.

The Crocodile represents the Larrakia people and other parts of the Northern Territory which has a significant cultural connection to our Indigenous players at the Suns.
