1. Program	 ✓ Scheduled school programming – minimum 210 minutes per week ✓ Umpiring program completed by all program participants, in junior age divisions ✓ Primary school catchment gala event support through umpires, coaches and general event assistance
2. Education	 ✓ Minimum Level 2 accreditation for all head coaches & Level 1 accreditation for assistant/line coaches ✓ Desired for head of program to be level 3 accredited. ✓ Attendance by all QSoE program staff and coaches to Professional Learning opportunities and Q Schools Events ✓ Engage in AFL education sessions i.e. mental health, wellbeing, cultural awareness
3. Play	 ✓ Play in all fixtured matches as scheduled in QSoE and Q Schools Cup ✓ Nominate teams in all QSoE divisions on offer i.e. JM, JF, SM, SF and modified play & disability inclusion
4. Compliance	 ✓ AFLQ Schools of Excellence shield on all playing uniforms ✓ AFLQ Schools of Excellence program promoted on school website and platforms ✓ Each team entered to have an approved home and clash playing strip ✓ All players and coaches registered via the relevant platforms – PlayHQ, Coach.AFL
5. Engagement	 ✓ Community club connection through recruitment, transition and promotion initiatives ✓ Provide opportunities at school events and programs, to promote Australian Rules Football
